2. REQUEST TO THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT FOR DEREGULATION IN NATIONAL STRATEGIC SPECIAL ZONES (RELAXATION OF STATUS OF RESIDENCE FOR FOREIGN COMPANIES, ETC.)

On August 29, the Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry made a total of 13 proposals as measures for Regulatory and Institutional Reforms in the National Strategic Special Zones in response to the invitation by the Cabinet Office, including the formation of "international & future medical care centers" and the promotion of foreign companies' entry into Japan.

In March, the Japanese government designated six areas around Japan, including the Kansai region (Osaka, Kyoto, and Hyogo prefectures), as National Strategic Special Zones in order to promote bold

Regulatory and Institutional Reforms. Each of those zones has established meetings of the zone, and is currently putting plans for the zone into concrete shape. In addition, the government is scheduled to invite new proposals for Regulatory and Institutional Reforms at least twice a year. This is the first of such invitations.

The OCCI's 13 proposals included seven (7) related to the medical field, three (3) related to the foreigner- and foreign company-related field, two (2) related to the tourism field, and one (1) related to the employment field. In the proposals for the medical field, the OCCI sought the expansion and improvement of combination therapies not covered by insurance in order to form an international & future medical care center with a highly dense agglomeration of medical and research institutions in an urban area of Osaka (the Second Development Zone in the Umekita Area.)

Toward its promotion of foreign companies' entry into Japan, the OCCI also requested that the government newly establish a status of residence for foreign companies and foreigners currently preparing for the establishment of their businesses, or to relax the conditions to obtain such status of residence.

3. MYANMAR AIRWAYS INTERNATIONAL BEGINS PROVIDING FLIGHT SERVICES FOR ITS KANSAI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT-YANGON ROUTE (FROM OCTOBER 8)

Myanmar Airways International will launch three charter flight services per week (on Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday) from October 8 (Wed), 2014 for its Osaka (Kansai) - via Phnom Penh (Cambodia) - Yangon (Myanmar) route.

While the outgoing route is from Kansai International Airport by way of Phnom Penh to Yangon, the incoming route involves direct flight services from Yangon to Kansai International Airport. Although (from December 1), the international airline aims to open regular flight services between Japan and Myanmar in the future.

Myanmar is now attracting great interest from Japanese companies as a promising destination of business operations in the future, in addition to Japan and Myanmar's diplomatic relationship marking its 60th anniversary this year. Cambodia is also attracting attention because Aeon Mall, the leading retailer in Japan, has opened its first outlet in this country this year. With improved convenience thanks to the direct flight services, future promotion of business-, cultural-, and tourism-related exchanges between the two countries are expected.

4. FIREEYE, INC. FROM THE U.S. FORMS A TIE-UP WITH KANDEN SYSTEM SOLUTIONS CO., INC., AND MAKES AN ENTRY INTO OSAKA

On August 4, the Osaka Business and Investment Center (O-BIC, which consists of the Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and Osaka prefectural and municipal governments, Secretariat: OCCI's International Division) announced that FireEye from the U.S., a leader in the cyber protection industry providing products and services against advanced cyber-attacks known as "targeted attacks," will establish a base in Osaka in order to expand its business in the Western Japan market.



Before its entry into Osaka, the company concluded a comprehensive partnership agreement in the information security field with Kanden System Solutions. According to FireEye's own research, Japan is a target country with the world's fourth highest risk for cyber-attacks.

Country Manager Masayuki Moteki of FireEye Japan expressed the following aspiration: "Since cyber-attack techniques have become complicated, it is difficult to prevent those attacks with conventional services.

We would like to protect the IT infrastructure of companies in Osaka with new solutions to be developed through the fusion of the two companies."
